Foundation Offers Health Care Coverage Solutions to Uninsured Commissioner Highlights Uninsured Help-Line

(Insurance.ca.gov) — With the state's unemployment rate topping 10 percent, Insurance Commissioner Steve Poizner recently highlighted the Foundation for Health Coverage Education Web site, coverageforall.org, a resource for those who may have lost their health insurance due to the tough economic times.

FHCE operates a U.S. Uninsured Help Line at (800) 234-1317 as a resource in addition to the Web site. The Web site and hotline are designed to provide access to hundreds of state and federal programs. The nonprofit organization currently provides access to 175 public health care program applications online, allowing Americans seeking government-sponsored health coverage to apply for the programs that are geared to meet their needs.
