(Arlington, VA) – The National Association of Health Underwriters (NAHU) last week announced its participation in Enroll America, a group waging a massive effort nationwide to reduce the number of uninsured Americans and provide educational resources on both public and private coverage options. We also have a long-standing partnership with the Foundation for Health Coverage Education to maintain 'Coverage for All,' a national health coverage database where consumers can find information on the public and private coverage options in their states. Local NAHU chapters also regularly sponsor enrollment days where professionally licensed health insurance agents and brokers volunteer countless hours to answer questions and fill out paperwork to enroll low-income families subsidized in health insurance programs. Our members also regularly respond to numerous inquiries regarding health coverage as a service to state and national elected officials.

"NAHU is committed to continuing and expanding its work to promote measures that curb medical costs, improve wellness, rein in frivolous lawsuits and expand consumer choice. We will continue to work with the administration, members of Congress and other organizations to help Americans access the best medical care in the world at an affordable price."
